St Sigfrid's Way is a recently developed pilgrimage route that begins in York and ends in Växjö (Sweden), and it travels through Berkshire. It is named after Sigfrid who was an 11th century pilgrim hailing from York, and who made the great journey to Sweden on the request of the Swedish king to bring the teachings of Christ to his people. The route will be walked in full this year for the first time by a small group of pilgrims, following an attempt last year which was aborted due to COVID. We very warmly invite you to join us for any length of the route that feels doable, or to simply greet us at the day's departure or arrival points.
