Holy Baptism within the Parish Mass

We wish you a very warm welcome to St Paul's this morning,
on this very special occasion.

The Children's Chapel was straight ahead of you as you came into Church this morning, and is a safe area for the children to play and join in with the service. There is also usually a Sunday School during the service to which you are welcome to send or take your children.

If you have any questions at all, about anything that's happening, please don't be afraid to ask. If you usually receive communion in your own church then you're very welcome to receive communion this morning. If you'd prefer to receive a blessing just come forward with everyone else and keep your head bowed at the rail. Gluten free wafers are available- please ask a Warden or server.

And if you're putting money in the collection plate today, thank you: if you use a white Gift Aid envelope then we can claim the tax back, and your £10 becomes worth £12.50 to us.

In the Mass we

- ❖ depart with the blessing of God, to live lives to his glory.

The Gathering

In the name of the Father, and of the Son,
and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**

Grace, mercy and peace from God our Father
and the Lord Jesus Christ, be with you all: **and also with you.**

The President introduces the service, using these and other words:

Our Lord Jesus Christ has told us that to enter
the kingdom of heaven we must be born again
of water and the Spirit, and has given us baptism
as the sign and seal of this new birth.

Here we are washed by the Holy Spirit and made clean.

Here we are clothed with Christ, dying to sin
that we might live his risen life.

As children of God, we have a new dignity
and God calls us to fullness of life.

Gloria in Excelsis

Glory to God, Glory to God, Glory to God in the Highest.

Glory to God in the Highest, and peace to his people on earth.

Lord God, heavenly King, Almighty God and Father,

we worship you, we give you thanks,

we praise you for your glory.

Glory to God, Glory to God, Glory to God in the Highest.

Lord Jesus Christ, only Son of the Father.

Lord God, Lamb of God, you take away the sin of the world;

have mercy on us;

you are seated at the right hand of the Father:

receive our prayer.

Jesus Christ, who is alive and reigns with you
in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and for ever. **Amen.**

The Liturgy of the Word

A Reading from the Bible

At the end, the reader says:

This is the word of the Lord: **thanks be to God.**

The Gospel (a reading from the life of Jesus)

*By tradition we turn to face the Gospel book, which symbolises
Christ dwelling amongst his people through his word.*

The Lord be with you. **And also with you.**

Alleluia, alleluia. This is my Son, the beloved,
with whom I am well pleased. **Alleluia.**

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ
according to N. **Glory to you, O Lord.**

At the end the priest says:

This is the Gospel of the Lord. **Praise to you, O Christ.**

The Sermon (*We consider what God is saying*)

The Liturgy of Baptism

Faith is the gift of God to his people.

In baptism the Lord is adding to our number
those whom he is calling.

People of God, will you welcome this child
and uphold (him/her) in their new life in Christ?

All: With the help of God, we will.

Parents and godparents,

the Church receives this child with joy.

Today we are trusting God for (his/her) growth in faith.

Will you pray for (him/her),

draw (him/her) by your example into the community of faith
and walk with (him/her) in the way of Christ?

Parents and Godparents: With the help of God, we will.

In baptism this child begins (his/her) journey in faith.

You speak for (him/her) today.

Will you care for (him/her),

and help (him/her) to take (his/ her) place
within the life and worship of Christ's Church?

P & G: With the help of God, we will.

The Decision

In baptism, God calls us out of darkness into his marvellous light. To follow Christ means dying to sin and rising to new life with him. Therefore I ask:

Do you reject the devil and all rebellion against God?

Parents and Godparents: I reject them.

Do you renounce the deceit and corruption of evil?

Parents and Godparents: I renounce them.

Do you repent of the sins that separate us from God and neighbour?

Parents and Godparents: I repent of them.

Do you turn to Christ as Saviour?

Parents and Godparents: I turn to Christ.

Do you submit to Christ as Lord?

Parents and Godparents: I submit to Christ.

Do you come to Christ, the way, the truth and the life?

Parents and Godparents: I come to Christ.

1. The Sign of the Cross

The Priest makes the sign of the cross on the forehead of each candidate with Oil for Baptism, saying:

Christ claims you for his own. Receive the sign of his cross.

Do not be ashamed to confess the faith of Christ crucified.

All: Fight valiantly as a disciple of Christ

against sin, the world and the devil,

and remain faithful to Christ to the end of your life.

The Baptism party move to the Font. The congregation turn to face the Font. You are invited to move so you can see what is going on.

2. The Water of Baptism

The Prayer over the Water

Praise God who made heaven and earth,

All: who keeps his promise for ever.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All: It is right to give him thanks and praise...

...Now sanctify this water + that, by the power of your Holy Spirit, they may be cleansed from sin and born again.

Renewed in your image, may they walk by the light of faith and continue for ever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Lord; to whom with you and the Holy Spirit be all honour and glory, now and for ever. **Amen.**

The Profession of Faith

Let us affirm, together with these who are being baptized, our common faith in Jesus Christ.

Do you believe and trust in God the Father, source of all being and life, the one for whom we exist?

All: I believe and trust in him.

Do you believe and trust in God the Son, who took our human nature, died for us and rose again?

All: I believe and trust in him.

Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit, who gives life to the people of God and makes Christ known in the world?

All: I believe and trust in him.

This is the faith of the Church.

All: This is our faith.

**We believe and trust in one God,
Father, Son and Holy Spirit.**

The Baptism

N, I baptise you in the name of the Father,
and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **All: Amen.**

May God, who has received you by baptism into his Church,
pour upon you the riches of his grace,
that within the company of Christ's pilgrim people
you may daily be renewed by his anointing Spirit,
and come to the inheritance of the saints in glory. **Amen.**

The Prayers of Intercession

During the prayers this response may be used:

Lord, hear us: **Lord, graciously hear us.**

The Welcome

There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism:
by one Spirit we are all baptized into one body.

**All: We welcome you into the fellowship of faith;
we are children of the same heavenly Father;
we welcome you.**

The Peace

The peace of the Lord be always with you: **and also with you.**

The Baptism party return to their seats after sharing the Peace.

The Liturgy of the Sacrament

Pray my brothers and sisters,
that our sacrifice may be acceptable
to God the almighty Father.

**May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands,
for the praise and glory of his Name,
for our good and the good of all his church.**

The Eucharistic Prayer

The Lord be with you. **And also with you.**

Lift up your hearts.

We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right to give thanks and praise.

Almighty God, good Father to us all,
your face is turned towards your world.

In love you gave us Jesus your Son
to rescue us from sin and death.

Your Word goes out to call us home
to the city where angels sing your praise.

We join with them in heaven's song:

Holy, holy, holy Lord,

God of power and might,

heaven and earth are full of your glory.

Hosanna in the highest.

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.

Hosanna in the highest.

Father of all, we give you thanks
for every gift that comes from heaven.
To the darkness Jesus came as your light.
With signs of faith and words of hope
