
Pews News

Electoral Roll

A revision of the Electoral Roll is due before the APCM this year, commencing from 3rd March 2024 until 31st March 2024, all applications to be received between these dates. If you reside in the parish or are a regular attendee at church you are eligible to apply for admission to the Roll. Application forms may be obtained from the sides persons, the Parish Office or Teri Austen. Anyone wishing to take an official post within the church, such as sidesperson, must have his or her name on the Electoral Roll. Likewise, anyone wishing to stand for election to the PCC or Deanery Synod must have had his or her name on the Roll for at least six months prior to the election and be an 'actual communicant' (Rule 54i of the Church Representation Rules). If you already have your name on the Electoral Roll, you do not need to apply afresh this year but, if your details have changed, please fill in a new application form. *Teri Austen*
